How to check your credit report



Step #1 Go to AnnualCreditReport.com.

Step #2 Click on "Request your free credit reports."

Step #3 Fill out the form to request one, two or three reports. (Enter your name, birthday, Social Security number and address.)

Step #7 Review your report to ensure that the information is correct and up-to-date.

Step #6 Write down your report number or print the report. (In the unlikely event that your computer crashes, you will need the report number to access the report again.)

Step #5 Answer a few questions about yourself. (This is a security measure to ensure that only you are able to access your online report.)

Step #4 Check the box for which report you would like to request (Experian, Equifax or TransUnion).

Get a free copy of your credit report every 12 months from each credit reporting company.
