This browser-based, Metro 2<sup>®</sup>-compliant system enables consumer data furnishers to address disputes.



REGISTER FOR e-OSCAR

Business data furnishers are not required to register for e-OSCAR.

Your **Data Specialist** will provide you with documentation to handle any reporting issues.

Contact your Consumer Data Specialist to coordinate sending a test file using **Experian's free Secure Transport Service** (STS) Web portal.



**TRANSMIT TEST FILE** 

Select encrypted transmission method including options; STS Web Portal (our website), **SFTP** (Secured Transport) or Connect Direct for efficient and secure delivery.

Review Experian's automated summary reports.

A Consumer Data Specialist will be available to help troubleshoot any errors with your test file.



**VALIDATE TEST FILE** 

**Review and approve Data Verification Packet** which includes samples and reports. A Data Acquisition Specialist will be available to help troubleshoot any errors.
