

Eligibility verification findings

Survey overview



Introduction

A recent GOVERNING Institute survey of 150 state and local government leaders highlights the growing need for eligibility verification and the prevalence of fraud across government agencies. In addition, because many government programs require individuals to qualify on more than one occasion, reverification of applicants poses yet another challenge. Only by ensuring beneficiaries are reverified regularly can state departments truly ensure program integrity.

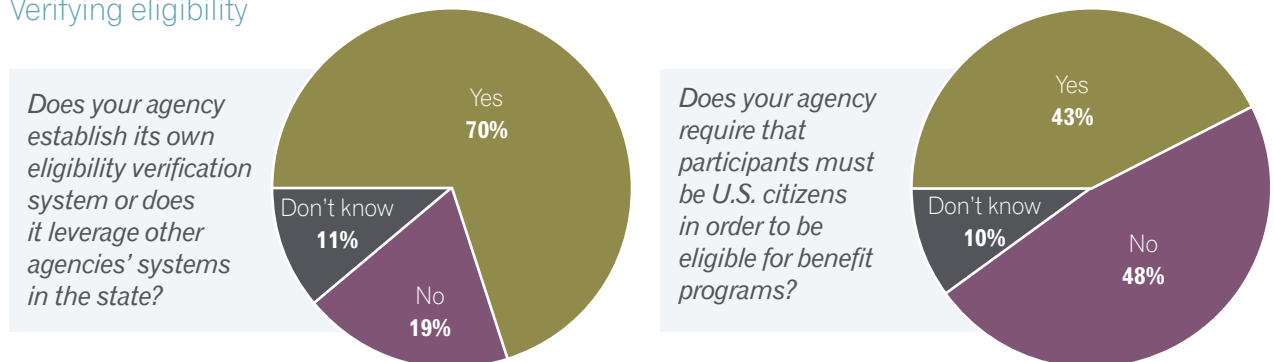
Survey overview

- GOVERNING surveyed **150 state and local government professionals** to determine their efforts on **eligibility verification**.
- Responses were gathered from the members of the GOVERNING Exchange in an online survey conducted in January 2013.
- The results are reflective of those who subscribe to either *GOVERNING* or *GovTech* magazine, with a maximum sampling error in this survey of +/- 8.7 percentage points at 95 percent confidence. Percentages have been rounded to the nearest whole number and may not total 100. The results of this survey cannot be projected to the entire population.

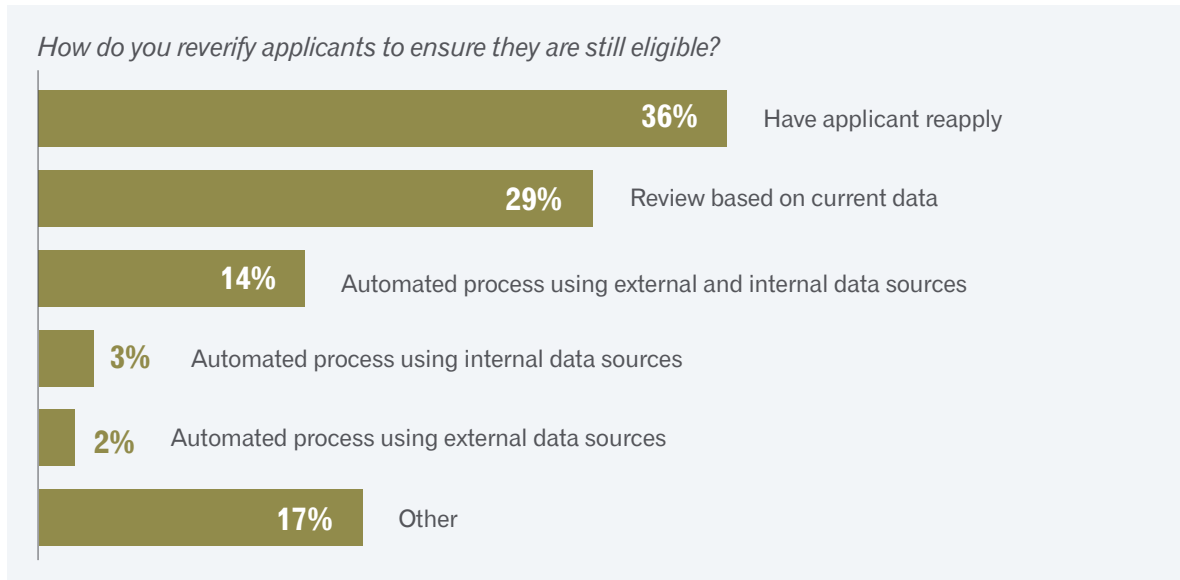
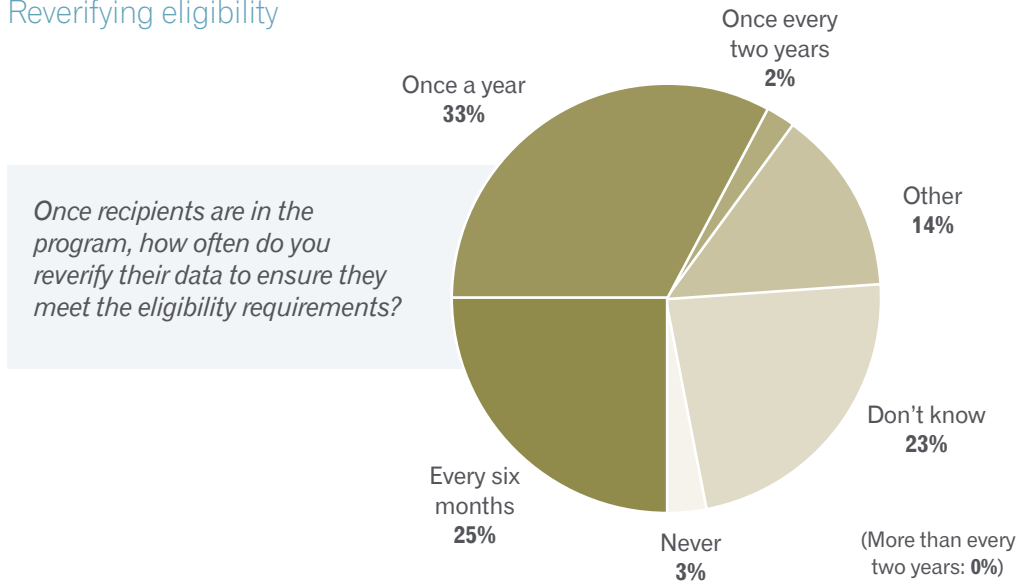
Verifying eligibility

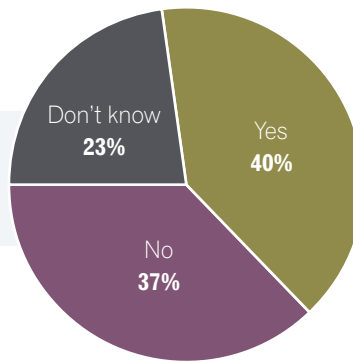
Understanding the issue

Eligibility verification is important

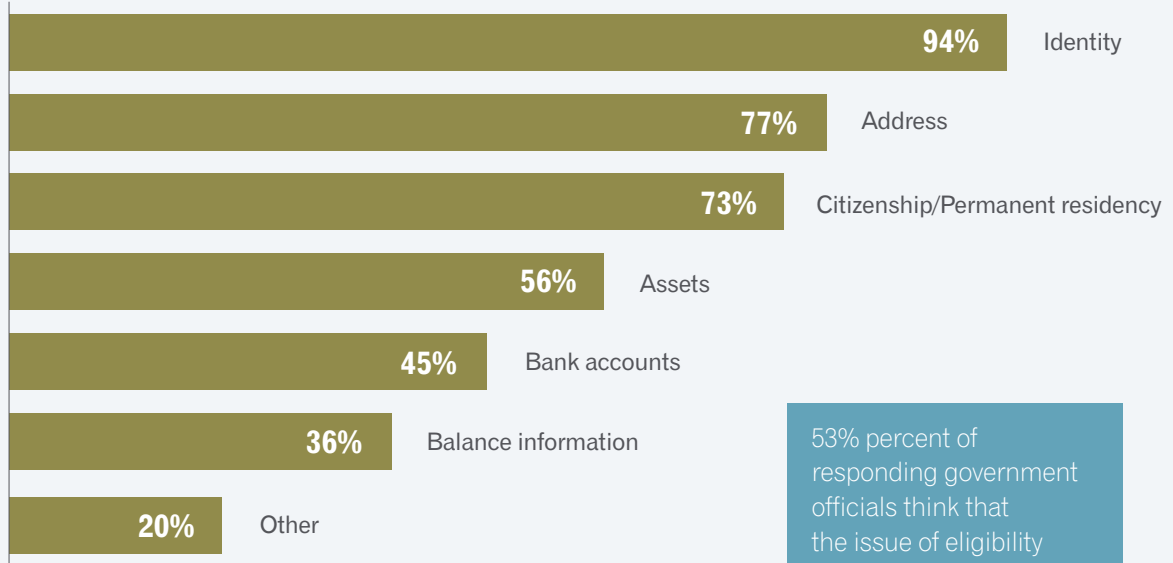
Respondents were asked to rate the level of importance of eligibility verification			
Importance	Eligibility verification versus other initiatives and priorities	Eligibility verification importance to achieve your agency's overall mission	Eligibility verification importance to your agency's political appointees
One of the most important	38%	29%	24%
Very important	50%	51%	26%
Somewhat important	11%	18%	28%
Not important	1%	2%	22%

Is it possible for a beneficiary to establish an identity in multiple jurisdictions?



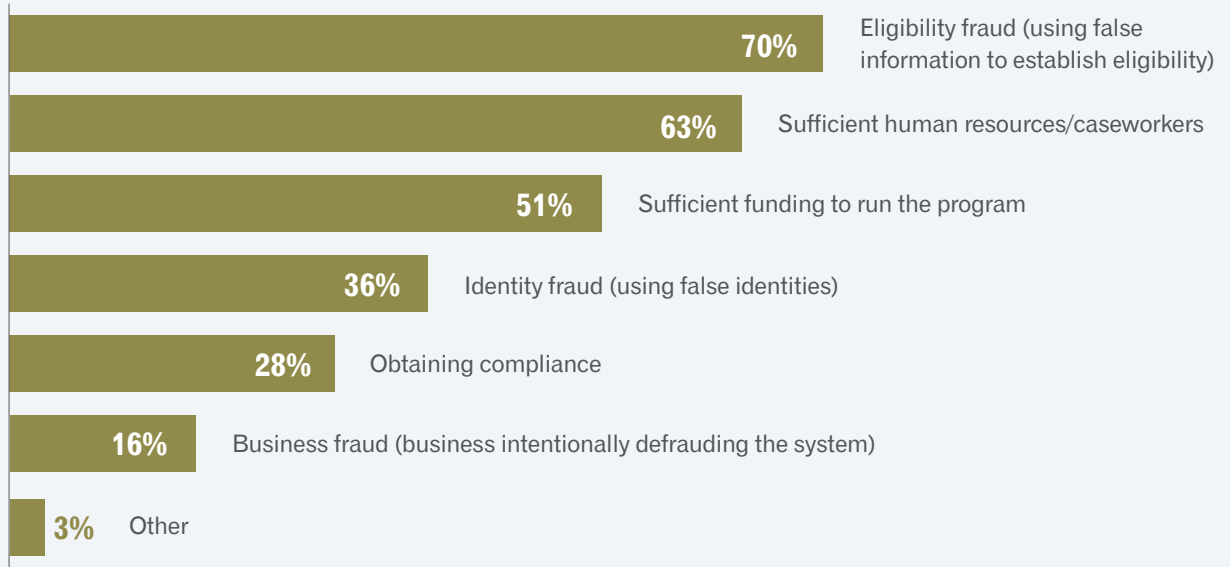
What types of applicant information does the state need to verify and validate?



53% percent of responding government officials think that the issue of eligibility fraud will increase in importance over the next two years.

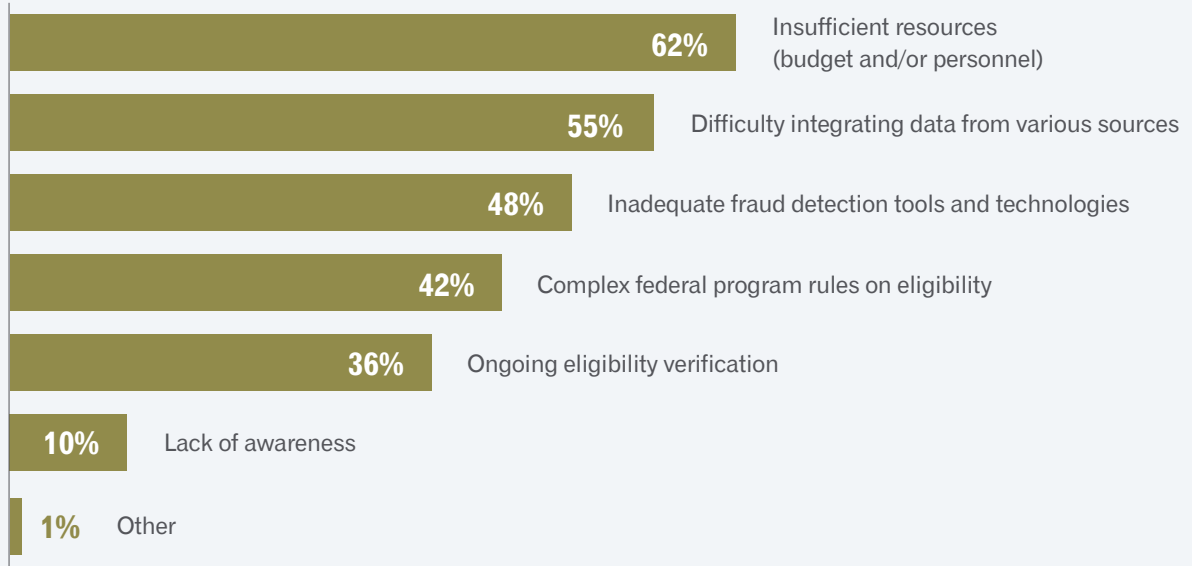
What are states trying to solve?

What are your agency's primary concerns surrounding eligibility?



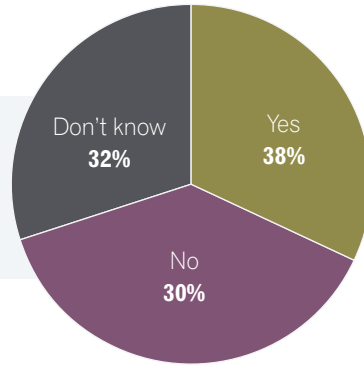
What's standing in the way?

Fraud detection

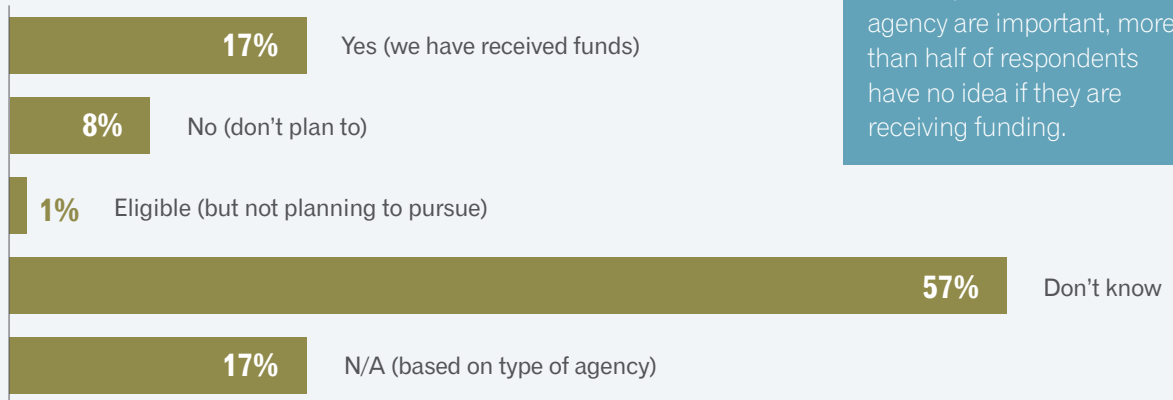
Do you currently leverage fraud detection analytics or risk models in your benefits programs to help detect fraud?

Eligibility verification funding

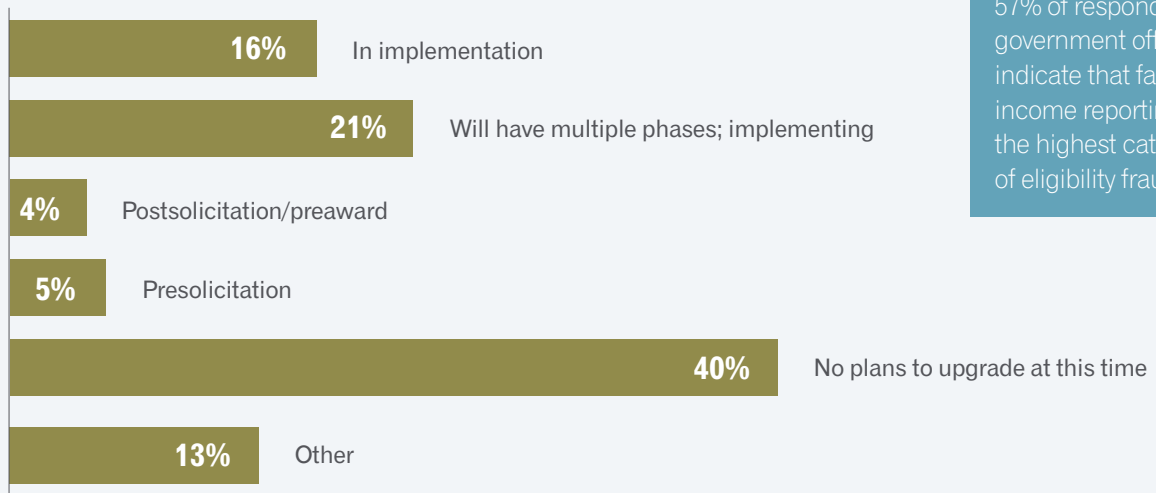
Where are you in the process of receiving funding through ACA/CMS?



Although 71% of respondents stated that efforts to reach constituents who require benefits/services from their agency are important, more than half of respondents have no idea if they are receiving funding.

Modernization is under way

If you have plans to upgrade or move toward an integrated eligibility system for statewide use, where are you in the process?



57% of responding government officials indicate that false income reporting are the highest category of eligibility fraud.

What are states looking for?

Top three features for program integrity:

1. Interfaces to federal/state verification sources **(53%)**
2. Validation of applicant information **(40%)**
3. Quality of data entered by caseworkers **(37%)**



Conclusion

The need to effectively address benefit-distribution challenges is the reason to go beyond the traditional methods of eligibility verification. Innovative tools based on data and analytics provide the ability for state agencies to create efficiencies and better combat fraud simultaneously. By reducing waste in government, agencies help curb federal debt and salvage state budgets.
