Understanding the impact of OBBBA changes

There's only a moderate, partial understanding of the act's impact.



14% Not well at all
35% Moderately well
10% Extremely well

How many providers are prepared?

Many providers are unprepared for OBBBA changes related to Medicare and Medicaid.

About 40% of providers require major updates or overhauls to prepare for the changes.

14% Fully prepared
44% Mostly prepared
10% Not prepared



Which areas in Medicare and Medicaid collections need the most change?

Eligibility and billing processes are the primary areas requiring improvement.

43% System upgrades for frequent eligibility checks and new work requirement compliance
42% Billing system configuration for Medicare and Medicaid claims
41% Medicaid eligibility and redetermination screening processes



Level of financial risk

Over half of providers report moderate-to-high risk to their RCM performance.

13% High risk – major revenue disruption
44% Moderate risk – potential for short-term impact
31% Low risk – can adapt with minimal impact
